# **&** Support

- 11,885 people received services from Sojourner staff
- 80,569 contacts were made with people in need
- 1,003 children impacted by family violence received care and support
- 55 kids attended Camp HOPE to build resilience and hope
- 4,283 people seeking safety via law enforcement received follow-up support from a Sojourner Advocate

# Hotline

• 17,952 calls from police officers, community members and survivors through our 24-hour hotline



• Provided 15,014 nights of shelter to 515 people fleeing domestic violence



## Advocacy

- 4,380 people seeking restraining orders received support
- 1,653 survivors visiting the District Attorney's office received help navigating the criminal court system



### Skills

- 565 survivors took control of personal empowerment through Hope & Healing programs
- 102 people participated in programs to learn healthy relationship skills as an alternative to violence
- · Support group sessions fostered positive connections for 205 people dealing with family violence



#### Public education

 4,393 people learned about topics including domestic violence, workplace impacts, teen dating, healthy relationships and more from a Sojourner representative
