Sojourner is one of the first in the nation to house holistic services for victims of domestic violence of all ages under one roof. In addition to moving our current shelter, Sojourner Truth House, and the 24-hour hotline, Sojourner is joining with Children's Hospital of Wisconsin to locate a Child Advocacy Center at the site. In this new facility, Sojourner and Children's Hospital, along with partners, will provide a more integrated system of services for adults and children who are impacted by domestic violence and child abuse.

## TRANSFORMING LIVES IMPACTED BY DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

While Sojourner Truth House, our emergency domestic violence shelter, remains one of our most recognizable programs, Sojourner staff and programs are integrated throughout the community. Staff are in schools, churches, police districts, at the courthouse and within the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

## CRISIS HOUSING

Sojourner provides crisis housing, support and assistance to women and children fleeing violence in their homes. Residents of Sojourner Truth House, our 46-bed emergency shelter, receive a broad array of supports and services during their stay that are focused on helping them achieve freedom from violence.

## SYSTEM ADVOCACY

Building a peaceful community necessitates that we address not only the immediate crisis, but also the root causes that keep women and children in unsafe environments. To this end, Sojourner actively partners with many community professionals such as the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office, the Milwaukee Police Department, educators, health professionals and others in an effort to assist survivors in navigating the many systems that may impact their lives after a violent incident.


## INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

Sojourner provides one-on-one and group support for survivors and offenders. Services and resources include: domestic violence education, emotional support, legal advocacy, job readiness, parent education, financial literacy and assistance finding housing and securing employment.

## YOUR GIFT IN ANY AMOUNT TRANSFORMS LIVES

- \$1,305 provides on scene, lifesaving services for a survivor through our partnership with law enforcement.
- \$608 breaks the cycle of violence by teaching a child to resolve conflicts peacefully and to treat others with respect.
- \$530 helps one survivor create a safety plan, connects them to community support and helps them rebuild their life.
- \$260 provides one survivor with a portion of their security deposit or first month's rent, helping them to live independently and violence free.
- \$150 prevents a survivor from having to face her abuser alone in the criminal justice system.
- \$46 ensures that an advocate is available to answer crisis calls for one hour on the hotline.
