Sojourner to announce new 24-hour domestic violence textline on PTSD Awareness Day at lakefront arts event

What:

Sojourner's President and CEO Carmen Pitre will announce the agency's new 24-hour domestic violence textline, giving survivors a new, accessible way to seek safety, shelter and support services at a time when domestic violence has drastically increased and related deaths are up 400% in the past two years.

The announcement is being made on Posttraumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) Awareness Day as an estimated 51-75% of intimate partner violence survivors experience PTSD. Sojourner will host a transformational, interactive papermaking workshop and large-scale art installation as part of Black Box Fund's Out of the Box Series.
